All About Camp Not-a-Clot!

The Hemophilia Foundation of Minnesota/Dakotas (HFMD) is collaborating with YMCA Camp Ihduhapi to host a traditional summer camp experience for campers with chronic bleeding disorders. The mission is to foster community among patients with bleeding disorders and promote transition to independence.

Who can attend: Children and teens with a chronic bleeding disorder, ages 8-17.

When is camp: Sunday, July 14th – Friday, July 19th, 2024.

Cost: The cost of camp is covered by HFMD (\$925/Camper). During the registration process with Camp Ihduhapi, you will be prompted to enter a coupon code to reflect this coverage during checkout. **The coupon code is: HEMOPHILIA**

Staff: The highly trained, skilled, and energetic Camp Ihduhapi staff provide a week of fun camp activities. They are supported during the week by medical professionals who provide bleeding disorder support and education. These medical professionals are from the regional Hemophilia Treatment Centers.

Accommodations: Campers spend their session with counselors and a group of other campers in a cabin. (Assignment based on age and gender.) All food is provided, including options for allergy and other dietary requirements. Camp is always peanut and shellfish-free.

Transportation: Drop off (Sunday July 14- early afternoon) and pick up (Friday July 19- early afternoon) is at YMCA Camp Ihduhapi. *Transportation is not provided*.

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

We recommend registering early! Registration has just a few steps, outlined below:

- **1. YMCA Registration**: Sign up on the YMCA Camp Website https://account.ymcanorth.org/PersonifyEbusiness/Product-Search/Product-Detail/ProductID/364245814
 - Registration can be completed on a computer or a mobile device, however we find the site is most user friendly on a computer or laptop.
 - The cost of camp is covered by HFMD. In the payment section, there will be a spot to enter a coupon code reflecting this coverage. You will have to click through several pages to get to that point.
 The Coupon Code is: HEMOPHILIA
- 2. Camp Docs: After registration, you will receive an email invitation to "Camp Docs." Here, you will fill out health and dietary information, camper questionnaire, and more. To ensure safety and the best experience for your child, it is important to complete this information in full.
- 3. Health Form *new process*: Camp Induhapi requires a healthcare provider form for each camper. This form is to be completed by your primary care provider (PCP). Please download the Health Exam Form in Camp Docs and request your PCP to complete and sign it. You must upload the completed form to the Healthcare Provider Form section of Camp Docs. This will not be completed by your Hematologist.
