Greetings from True Friends and HFMD. We are pleased to announce the 30th year of our summer camp, a partnership between the Hemophilia Foundation of MN/Dakotas (HFMD), True Friends and your regional Hemophilia Treatment Centers (HTCs). **This year camp will again be held at Courage North in Lake George, MN.** Lake George is located approximately 3½ hours NW of the Twin Cities.

We will be offering a camp session for boys and girls ages 8 through 17 years with significant bleeding disorders that will run from **Sunday July 7th – Friday July 12th**. Some 7-year-olds may be eligible based on an assessment by the HTC your child attends.

Applications are due by June 7, 2019 - this application reserves a place at camp for your child, and placement will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Camp tends to fill up quickly, so please return the forms as possible.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION:

Camp is sponsored by the HFMD and your Regional HTC and is offered at NO CHARGE to your child with a bleeding disorder.

The Hemophilia Foundation of Minnesota/Dakotas, your Regional HTC, and True Friends provide young people with bleeding disorders the opportunity to attend summer camp at Courage North. Any boy or girl in Minnesota, North Dakota and South Dakota with a significant bleeding disorder, who wants to attend camp, is eligible to have their entire camp fee paid for by the HFMD. The packing list will be included in the Camper Handbook that each camper will receive in the mail after registering. Please contact your HTC Social Worker if you need financial assistance with items on the packing list. **No child will be turned away because of a lack of funding.**
